Narrative: Submitted on 12/8/2011 : While on patrol I observed a red Chevrolet S10 pull into the gas station at 548 North Ave NW from east bound on North Ave NW. A male, later identified as Ryan Lisabeth got out of the car and walked inside the Chevron gas station. When he walked out of the store I approached him and began a consensual encounter. I asked him where he was coming from and he stated his home in Riverdale. I asked him where he was going and he told me to visit his friend who lived near Georgia Tech. I explained to Mr. Lisabeth that his story did not make any sense because he would not need to travel east bound on North Ave to reach Georgia Tech if he was coming from Riverdale. I asked Mr. Lisabeth if he had come into Atlanta to buy drugs and he stated that he did, but that he had not bought any yet. I then asked him to be honest and he told me that he had some cocaine in his pocket. I asked him to please hand it to me and he handed me a green bag of heroin from his sweat shirt pocket. He said that he told me it was cocaine because it sounded "less harsh". He also told me that he had a needle in the center console of his vehicle which I took. I placed Mr. Lisabeth under arrest. His dog, Kira, was inside his truck. Mr. Lisabeth's mom, Deborah Lisabeth, came to the scene and took possession of Kira and Mr. Lisabeth's truck because animal control could not be reached. I transported Mr. Lisabeth to the Fulton County Jail. Narrative: Submitted on 5/26/2013 : On May 26, 2013 at approximately 1105 hrs., I , Officer J. Whitfield, was on patrol and pulled into the Chevron parking lot at 548 North Ave. The area is known for extremely high illegal drug activity. I observed a red Chevrolet S10 pickup with a white male driver parked at the northwest gas pump facing south. The driver appeared to be reaching toward the center console and seemed to be very focused on what he was doing. I have witnessed persons on many occasions injecting heroin at this location, and suspected that the male might be doing so. I parked my patrol car facing south on the other side of the same gas pump that the S10 was parked at. I exited my vehicle and observed in plain view from the driver side window that the male, Mr. Ryan Michael Lisabeth, was facing the center console with a syringe in his right hand. Mr. Lisabeth still had not noticed that I was standing beside his vehicle. I observed a bottle cap from a bottled water on the center console, and noticed that the bottle cap contained a brownish colored liquid that I suspected to be heroin. I also observed a small blue baggie commonly used for packaging drugs in Mr. Lisabeth's lap. I knocked on the window and instructed Mr. Lisabeth to place the syringe on the center console and to step out of the vehicle. Mr. Lisabeth then placed the syringe on the center console at exited the vehicle. I asked Mr. Lisabeth what was he had in the bottle cap. Mr. Lisabeth stated that he had just purchased a \$10 bag of herion in "the bluff", and was preparing to inject it. Mr. Lisabeth stated that he had been clean from drug use for nearly a year after 7 years of use, but that he had recently relapsed. Mr. Lisabeth was placed under arrest and charged with 16-13-30, heroin possession, and 16-13-32, possession of drug related objects. Mr. Lisabeth was transported to Fulton Co. Jail by Unit 2115. The vehicle was impounded by S&W Towing. The bottle cap, suspected heroin, blue baggie, and syringe were turned in at property as evidence. Mr. Lisabeth's cell phone was turned in at property as property.

Narrative: Submitted on 7/30/2013 : On July 29, 2013 I Ofc. R. Dobler was dispatched to the intersection of Hemphill Ave. and Northside Dr. for what was determined to be a car accident. Upon my arrival I noticed a red Chevy S10 pick up parked up half way on the road and the other half on the raised median. I walked up to the driver side door where I then noticed the driver later identified as Ryan Lisabeth slumped over the steering wheel. I asked Ms. Kellen Flatt the driver of the other car what happened and she advised that she was in another car and was struck by the Chevy S10 and that she believed Mr Lisabeth was intoxicated as he kept passing out. I then poked at Mr. Lisabeth's left shoulder and told him to wake up, Mr. Lisabeth the slowly lifted his head up and began talking to me at a slow rate. I asked Mr. Lisabeth what happened he stated that he was running late for Drug Counseling and that he got in to a car accident, at this time I noticed that Mr. Lisabeth's eyes were glazed over and that his pupils were very small. Grady 336 then arrived on scene. I told Grady 336 what happened. Grady 336 then brought Mr. Lisabeth to the ambulance. Ofc. K. Davis Unit 3504 then arrived on scene to assist me with the car accident. I then walked to the back of Grady 336 where I then asked Mr. Lisabeth if he was on some type of Narcotic. Mr. Lisabeth at this time would not stop rubbing his nose, he kept scratching at his nose Mr. Lisabeth stated that he was scratching at his nose because it was hot and he was sweating and the sweat was itching his nose. I asked Grady 336 if Mr. Lisabeth had any injuries from the accident and they advised that there were no injuries. Grady 336 did advised that Mr. Lisabeth's blood pressure was extremely high and that they believed that with Mr. Lisabeth's slow speech that he was on some type of Narcotic. I then placed Mr. Lisabeth under arrest. I then immediately read Mr. Lisabeth the Georgia Implied Consent Notice at 336PM. Mr. Lisabeth was then transported by myself to the Atlanta City Jail for a Chemical Test to be Administered by the onsite Nurse. Mr. Lisabeth than advised me and Atlanta City Correction at 438PM that he would no longer like to submit to any tests. Mr. Lisabeth was arrested for Following Too Closely 40-6-49, Reckless Driving 40-6-390 and DUI/Drugs/Less Safe 40-6-391(a)(2). Mr. Lisabeth was arrested with out incident.
