Dear Tree Canopy Stakeholders,

After multiple conversations and much consideration, this Thursday's tree rewrite work session will be postponed for a number of weeks until our current health crisis is in a more stable place.

Protecting our 'City in the Forest' is a critically important priority for Atlanta. In the intervening weeks, we will work closely with the Planning Department, community stakeholders, and the public to keep the city on track for final passage in August. In order to keep the process of feedback moving forward, we plan to continue conversations with stakeholders as the City continues to work toward a second draft, including holding an inperson meeting with the public when safe to do so. In the meantime, we want your input.
