What is Project Light?

Hate cannot drive out hate; only love can do that.” This project was born out of Leadership Atlanta, and is a culmination of leaders from various classes and beyond to stand up for justice and make a positive impact to society.

Our goal is to be the light during times of darkness and show firm love in times of hate.

I Signed Up, Now What Do I Do?

Thanks for taking the time to sign the petition for Project Light. Our goal is to help in the effort in getting HB 426 passed in the Georgia Senate. To do this, we need to assist in the hard work that many others have been doing to help get the word out. We want to make sure we do our part in supporting this effort and help make change.

Here are the action items of what to do next:

- 1) Sign the petition. Before you start anything, please go to <https://www.change.org/PassHateCrimeBill> and sign. Why is this important, you will be asking others to sign, so you want to make sure you sign it yourself.
- 2) Email Senators from the list provided in More Information Section. You can email all or a select few that you deem appropriate. The goal is send a message to the Senators of our state that we need this bill passed.
- 3) Email your Friends Circle and Community/Institution Groups. It's important that you get the word out into your respective circles to get broader support on getting the bill passed. In the email campaign section we have some templated emails you can use to make it easier. If you feel you want to send an email with your own message, that works as well. We just ask that you attached the letter (that you signed) as well as include the link to the petition in your email.

- 4) Please post messages up on your social channels. It's about getting as many touchpoints as possible on support of passing the bill. In the Social Engagement section below there is suggested language for posting and a cadence. Feel free to use your own wording if you wish. But at a minimum please try to post once a week on this subject.
- 5) Have the conversation. Please bring this topic up in your relevant circles and where you deem appropriate. It's important that we keep pushing the message on supporting the passing of HB 426.
- 6) Last but not least, please like the Project Light Facebook page. Updated information will be posted there, so you don't want to miss out.

Re: Hate Crime Legislation in Georgia

May 17, 2020

Dear Lt. Governor Duncan, Senate Judiciary Committee Chairman Jesse Stone & Remaining State Senators,

We are a group of concerned Georgians brought together as participants in the **Leadership Atlanta (LA) Class of 2020, the 50th Anniversary Class and supporting LA Alumni**. We represent leaders from major corporate, civic, education, philanthropic and faith-based organizations. We have made a commitment to each other, our families, our colleagues, our classmates and to our communities to stand together and stand up for love and stand against hate. As we stand together, we stand up for justice and stand against injustice.

We, the authors of this letter, have either experienced discrimination and hate because of the color of our skin or have reaped the benefits of white privilege. Regardless of our upbringing, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity, cultural background, country of origin or the color of our skin, we have pledged publicly and to one another that we will raise our voices and advocate for those that do not have the platform to advocate for themselves. We have pledged to use our influence and leverage our networks and platforms to ensure that every community across the state of Georgia is a place where all our citizens live in harmony, have equal protection, equal opportunity, and equal justice.

It is with this thought in mind that we are raising our voices to thank the House of Representatives for passing [House Bill 426](#) and now stand together to petition the Senate Judiciary Committee to continue the execution without delay or amendment. The State of Georgia is only one of four states in the United States that does not have formal hate crime legislation. It is time for our State Leaders to stand up and declare that Georgia will stand for love and will not tolerate hate. Now is the time for Georgia to take its rightful place as the leader in civility, love, and justice for every one of our citizens; not just those born with the right skin color, religious affiliations, cultural heritage, or sexual preference. We seek to put the human back into humanity. Every Georgian deserves equal protection under the law and equal justice when their rights are violated.

As corporate and public leaders, we are appreciative of your leadership in making Georgia the number one state in which to do business. We should also lead the way in protecting victims of crimes involving injustice and prejudice establishing precedent that perpetrators will be prosecuted at the highest level possible rather than watching our state being mocked for intolerance and hate. Covid-19 cannot be an excuse for injustice against any group. We can and must do better. This is the obligation we have as leaders. Our inspirational leaders of the past like Robert W. Woodruff and Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. stood for love and stood against hate. We petition that our current leaders take up this mantle and do the same. Now is your time to create your legacy. A legacy that we can all be proud of.
